

Theo Jansen is not only passionate of technology (engineer), but the potential material building incredible creature.






 Several decades... Theo experimented a new nature using yellow plastic tubes and light materials as the key elements in the structure and function of all living cells.




# fLUX binary waves




- Site Analysis:
  - Infrastructure : passengers, car
  - Communication: mobile phone & radio...
  - Geographic condition
- Kinetic rules urban activities











- Size: 32 rotating and luminous panels of 3 meter-high and 0.60 meter wide, placed every 3 meters
- Element of the Binary Waves:
  - Urban activities
- Rotation- vertical axis
- Black reflective surface I side
- Controlled by microprocessor



- The microprocessors are connected to infrared sensors, capturing the surrounding infrastructural flows, defining the frequency and amplitude of the rotation.
- unfied play of light, colours and sounds directly derived from the rhythm of the city flows.
- urban flows in a contemporary play of kinetics, lights and sound.








Bonnemaison and Macy's work with dancer's motion transformed into tangible, habitable structures called Gestures
